

#### From the Pastor


This week I will be spending a few days up in Matheson Island with Terrell Wiebe (youth minister at Altona Bergthaler Church). We will be making plans with church elders in the community for the summer day camp our youth will be helping to lead on the island in July.



Matheson Island is located at the narrows of Lake Winnipeg. The community has a population of around 140. Commercial fishing is the number one source of income for the community and area.

The island and community were called Matheson Island after Daniel Matheson, the man who was the caretaker of the lighthouse from 1891 to 1918 on Black Bear Island, which is just north-east of the island. The Matheson family was originally from Aultbreakachy, Sutherland, Scotland. Daniel Matheson's grandfather arrived in Churchill, Manitoba in 1813, before traveling the next 700 miles to the Red River Settlement by canoe.

Matheson Island School, which is part of the Frontier School Division, serves to educate the community's children. There are a total of 18 students that attend from nursery to grade 9.
